Committee advised that the question papers should avoid the What, Explain, Discuss type of direct questions, rather the orientation of question papers should be towards the applications covering multiple topics.

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Committee also suggested that while designing syllabus, pre-requisite, objective and outcome for each subject should also be mentioned. Reference should have a consistent formatting in terms of author names, publisher, year and edition. Dean (AA) may be requested to initiate the process of incorporating these revisions in the syllabus.

Item No. 1.03: To apprise the Board for Course and Syllabi of 1st Year of new program M.Tech.

- Green Technology as already approved by the Academic Council

Committee appreciated the efforts put in for starting a new M.Tech program in Green Technology. However, Committee was of view that Green Technology specialization may be very narrow and may create employability problems or equivalent issues if a candidate opts for research career and takes admission in PhD program. Committee suggested that M.Tech. (Green Technology) may be run jointly by BAS and Architecture Departments and may be renamed as M.Tech. (Environmental Sciences) with specialization in Green Technology or M.Tech. (App. Science) with specialization in Green Energy or similar other options. As the program has already been approved by the Academic Council, the suggestion of BoS may be placed before the Committee in next Academic Council Meeting.

Item No. 1.04: To apprise the Board for Supervisor directed Course and Syllabi of PhD Course Work as already approved by the Academic Council

Committee examined the courses in detail and suggested that for supervisor led courses for PhD course work, the subjects selected from NPTEL or other MOOC courses like COURSERA or EDX should have separate university codes. These subjects should be identified by their IGDTUW defined subject codes and not by NPTEL etc. NPTEL courses may be given as reference.

Item No. 5.2: To consider and recommend the Guidelines and Evaluation Scheme of all the UG and PG programs under Faculty of Engineering and Technology as per CBCS

Board deliberated the guidelines in details. Chairman suggested that Allied Elective Courses should be renamed as Open Elective Courses. Also, members suggested that separate detailed guidelines be prepared for evaluation of MOOC courses, project and research work selected by a student under Generic Open Elective courses. It was also suggested that in case of an elective subject, minimum ceiling of students for floating an elective be 30% in place of 40%.

With the minor changes, Board recommended the revised Guidelines and Evaluation Scheme of all the UG and PG programs under Faculty of Engineering and Technology as per CBCS.

Item No. 5.3: To consider and approve the Teaching Scheme and Syllabus of BTech. 1st Year for all Branches as per CBCS

Members suggested the revision in Course Outcomes in line with NBA and updation of references. With these minor changes, Board recommended the Teaching Scheme and Syllabus of BTech. 1st Year for all Branches as per CBCS

Board suggested that Modelling and Simulation subject should be transferred from 3rd semester to 5th semester. It should be replaced with Digital Circuits and Systems (from 4th semester) and the slot created in 4th semester should be filled by Digital System Design (from 5th semester).

It is also suggested that BEC-301 to be renamed as Digital Communication Systems, BEC-401 to Microwave Techniques, BEC -412 to Wireless Networks, BEC-311 to Random Signals & Processes. Optical Communication and Networks, Radar Engineering, Satellite Communication, Electronic Measurement & Instrumentation and Multimedia Communication to be included as Elective subjects. Wireless MIMO to be replaced by the suggested Electives.

With these minor changes, Board recommended the Teaching Scheme of BTech-ECE for 2nd, 3rd and 4th year and syllabus of BTech-ECE 2nd Year as per CBCS.

HoD-CSE briefed the Board about the declining trend of admission in existing MTech-MPC program in previous years. Because of growing demand of researchers and professionals from Artificial Intelligence domain and for better acceptability of students in industry and research, she proposed to replace it with a more generic program, MTech- CSE with specialization in Artificial Intelligence. After detailed deliberations, Board recommended the replacement of existing M.Tech.- MPC program with the new program, MTech- CSE with specialization in Artificial Intelligence. Members suggested that first semester should be

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generic and remaining semesters should have the specialised subjects from Artificial Intelligence stream. Also, members suggested to change the names of Minor Project (Semester 3) and Dissertation (Semester 4) to Dissertation-I and Dissertation-II respectively in all four MTech Programs.

With the changes, Board recommended the replacement of existing M.Tech.-MPC with MTech.-CSE with specialization in Artificial Intelligence along with Teaching Scheme for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st semester as per CBCS.

Item No. 5.9: To consider and approve the closing of MTech - ISM and start of new MTech-IT (ISM) along with Teaching Scheme for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st semester as per CBCS

HoD-IT briefed the Board about the existing MTech-ISM program and proposed to replace it with MTech-IT with specialization in Information Security Management to make the program more generic and better acceptable in industry, research and academic domains. After detailed deliberation, Board recommended to replace the existing MTech-Information Security Management program with MTech- IT with specialization in Information Security Management along with the teaching scheme for 1^{st} and 2^{nd} year and Syllabus of 1^{st} semester as per CBCS.

Item No. 5.10: To consider and approve the Teaching Scheme of MTech-VLSI Design for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS

Board recommended to replace the existing MTech-VLSI Design program to MTech-ECE with specialization in VLSI and Design. Board also recommended the teaching scheme for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS

Item No. 5.11: To consider and approve the Teaching Scheme of MTech-R&A for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS

Board deliberated the teaching scheme and syllabus for the MTech R&A program. Members suggested that the syllabus of Advanced Digital signal processing be revised. It was suggested that the subject Machine Vision (MRA 106) under Department Elective 1 in 2nd Sem, should be swapped with Optimization for Engineering (MRA 205) Department Elective 3 (3rd sem). Similarly, the subject Advanced Robotics (MRA 104) under Department Core in

2nd Sem, was proposed to be swapped with Computer Integrated Manufacturing (MRA 201) Department core in 3rd sem.

With these minor changes, Board recommended the Teaching Scheme of MTech-R&A for 1st and 2nd year and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS

Item No. 5.12: To consider and approve the Teaching Scheme of MCA for all three years and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS

Board deliberated the teaching scheme of MCA and suggested that System Analysis and Design subject be removed from 2nd semester and Software Engineering be transferred from 3rd semester to 2nd semester (in place of System Analysis and Design course). In 3rd semester, a new subject Cloud Computing be introduced.

With these minor changes, Board recommended the Teaching Scheme of MCA for all three years and Syllabus of 1st year as per CBCS.
