Minutes of the Meetings

Sub: Meeting with the Students for deliberations on feedback

To deliberate the feedback received from the students of the various Departments, the Meeting of the duly constituted Committee comprising of HoDs of the various Departments along with students was held on 18th January, 2019, at 3:00 PM in the Auditorium. During the meeting the various suggestions given by the Students were deliberated. The students were asked to share their opinion about the curriculum, placements, infrastructure, expert lectures etc., and to suggest improvements to be made, if any

During the deliberations with the panel of the HoDs, the following points were suggested by the students:

- 1. Students acknowledged that the present syllabus is very comprehensive and the classes are being conducted from 6 to 7 hours per day, they do not get the ample time to learn the various skills and technologies which are required to be industry ready. The students suggested the following:
- i) The number of credits required for the completion of program be reduced so that they can get sufficient time for self-learning.
- ii) The curriculum may give the option to the students to select the courses of their interests from the other disciplines also. Moreover, a bouquet of generic elective may also be included for the overall holistic development of the students.
- iii) Internship after every year may also be added in the curriculum so that they get the sufficient exposure for working on innovative real world problems in the industry.
- iv) During the deliberations, students mentioned that placements of the University is increasing every year. However, to increase the network further, an Industry-Alumni Meet may be conducted by the University every year. The interaction with the alumni

- will help the students in understanding the advancements in the technology so that they become industry ready.
- v) Students also mentioned that the opportunity for carrying out the final semester project based on the research or industry may be considered so that they can get industry experience while they are studying.
- vi) The students also suggested to enhance the digital aid for the conduct of the classes and creation of the new labs for hands-on experience of latest tools and technologies.

At the end of the meeting, the Students appreciated the opportunities given to them to provide their feedback and observations that will help the University in improving teaching learning eco-system and building up intensive relationship with the industry.

Minutes of the Meetings

Sub: Meeting with the Parents of the students

A meeting of the duly constituted committee of the HoDs along with the parents of the students was convened on 9th February, 2019 in an Online mode. Along with HoDs from various departments, more than 75 parents joined the meeting.

At the outset, HoD (IT) welcomed all the parents who have spared their valuable time out of their busy schedule. He further briefed the parents that their feedback and suggestions on the various perspectives will enable the University to take corrective action timely. This will not only help in the teaching-learning eco-system but also will affect the future batches.

During the extensive deliberations with the parents, the following points have been recommended for consideration by the University: -

- 1. That the syllabus is very time consuming and do not permit their wards to concentrate on other development activities.
- 2. Presently two mid Semester examination are conducted which exhaust a lot of time of academic development of the students. It is suggested to conduct only one mid-semester exam to give more time for teaching-learning process and to provide the space for self-learning.
- 3. Parents raised their concern about monitoring the conduct of the classes.
- 4. The parents thanked the University for Excellent Placement. However, suggested to have Industry-Alumni Meet at least once in a year. This will give the opportunities to the students to interact with their seniors who are already working in the industry. These interactions will facilitate the perspective engineers to learn and understand the technological development in their respective areas.
- 5. The parents suggested to pay attention on improving the lab infrastructure and use of digital-aid in conduct of the classes.

At the end of the Meeting, parents have expressed their gratitude that the future of their wards is in right hand and University is making all efforts towards the bright and rising future of the students.

Industry Experts appreciated the efforts of the University for providing excellent environment for the students. They also acknowledged the rich curriculum and involvement of the students in learning new industry trends for their overall development. Experts were very happy to know about the achievements of the students and the University at large.

During the extensive deliberations with the experts, the following points have been recommended for consideration by the University: -

- 1. More flexibility to be provided to the students to study interdisciplinary subjects from the other Departments of the University.
- 2. Emphasis on Soft skills/communication skills. Students should be encouraged for presentation skills and team working.
- 3. Though curriculum has one compulsory internship after 3rd year of students, however, industry experts suggested that students should get more opportunities for carrying out internships in industries. This will help them in upgrading their technical skills on latest technologies.
- 4. Industry Expert suggested that students should take part in various competitions including National & International Hackathon, to get an exposure of working in a competitive environment. They should participate in various challenges organized by companies like TCS, IBM, Google, Amazon and others to get recognition at International level. Apart from their participation, they should also organize events at large level to learn managerial and learn skills for their holistic development.
- 5. Experts also mentioned that the meetings with Industry may be made on regular basis at least once in a year, where they can discuss and suggest the changes in the curriculum as Industry requirement.
