COMMUNITY OUTREACH IN BURARI SCHOOL

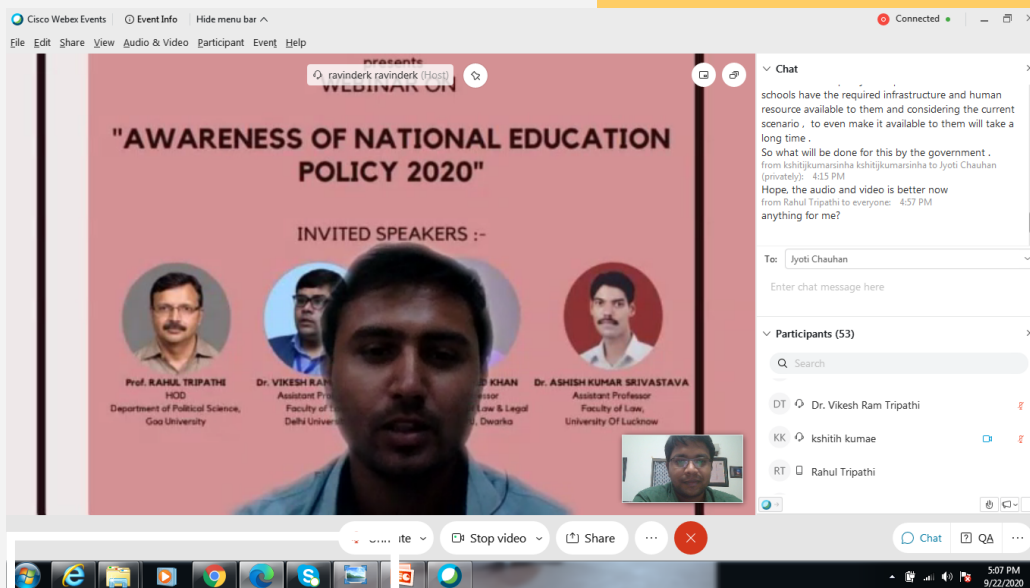
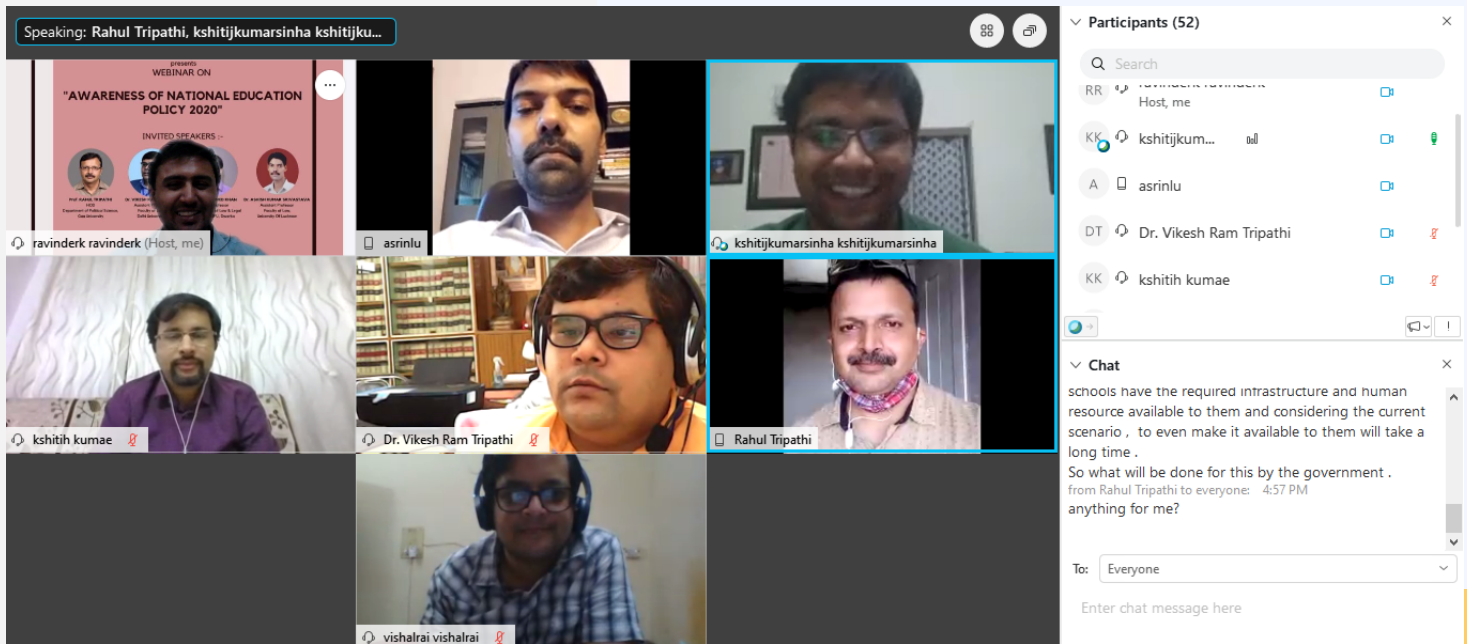

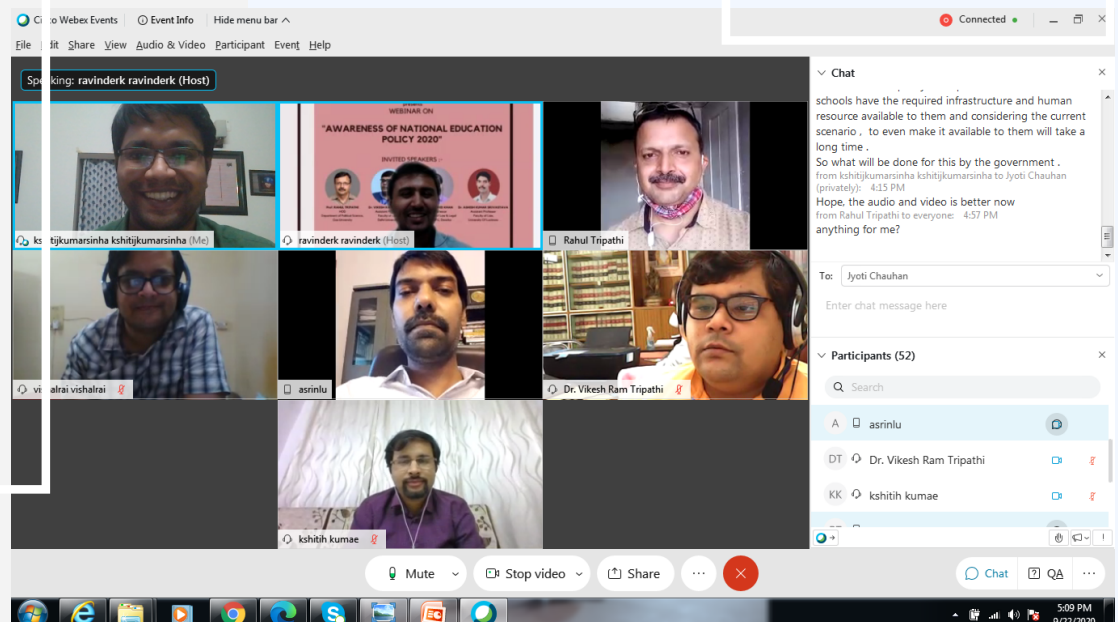
