6. Reservation Policy

Delhi Region

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

Outside Delhi

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

NOTE: For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the N.C.T. of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside N.C.T. of Delhi, she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.

- **a) Scheduled Caste (SC):** 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.
- **b) Scheduled Tribe (ST):** 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.
- **c) Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL):** 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.
- **d) Economically Weaker Section (EW):** 10% of the total seats are reserved for EW category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019

Sub-categories namely 'Defence' and 'Person with Disability' are available under each category (General, SC, ST, OBC-NCL).

- **e) Defence (CW):** 5% of the total seats (Horizontal) in each main category are reserved for candidates belonging to Defence sub-category in the following order of priority:
- **Priority I** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.
- **Priority II** Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.
- **Priority III** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.
- **Priority IV** Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service.

Priority V - Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel/para military/police personnel who are in receipt of the following Gallantry Awards: 1. Param Vir Chakra 2. Ashok Chakra 3. Mahavir Chakra 4. Kirti Chakra 5. Vir Chakra 6. Shaurya Chakra 7. Sena/Nau Sena/ Vayu Sena Medal 8. Mention-in-Despatches 9. President's Police Medal for Gallantry 10. Police Medal for Gallantry

Priority VI – Wards of Ex-servicemen.

Priority VII – Wives of:

- 1. Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service
- 2. Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service
- 3. Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry awards.

Priority VIII – Wards of serving personnel.

Priority IX - Wives of serving personnel.

f) Person with Disability (PD): 5% of the total seats (Horizontally) in each category are reserved for candidates belonging to 'Person with Disability' subcategory in accordance with the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016' (PwD Act).

Note:

- i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- iii. Seats under sub-category (f) are interchangeable within the sub-category if sufficient number of candidates are not available in a particular group.
- iv. In case, sufficient number of eligible candidates from the sub categories mentioned at (e) and (f) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved in the respective category.
- v. Under CW sub-category, the seats will be filled based on the priority, i.e., all eligible candidates of priority-I will be allotted seats based on their ranks until the ranks

exhaust or seats exhaust under CW sub category. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be allotted to the priority-II in the similar way, and so on.

vi. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.

vii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/sub categories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EW categories, CW/PD sub-categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category/ sub-category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category/ sub-category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category.

7. Important Pointers

Candidate will be eligible for final seat allotment subject to the following conditions:

- (i) verification of all documents at the time of counseling and fulfilling of the eligibility criteria
- (ii) availability of seat in the required field and payment of fees for the program.

8. Seat Conversion Rules

- 1) After exhausting the complete list of SC, ST, OBC and EW candidates, the vacant seats will be treated as unreserved. The conversion of vacant Outside Delhi Region seats to Delhi Region seats is as per the following procedure:
 - a) If the complete list of ST, Outside Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of SC, Outside Delhi category candidates or versa.
 - b) If the complete list of SC/ST, Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled by creating equal number of seats in GN, Delhi category.
 - c) If the complete list of SC/ST, Outside Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled by creating equal number of seats in GN, Outside Delhi category.

- d) If the complete list of EW, Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GN, Delhi category candidates.
- e) If the complete list of EW, Outside Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GN, Outside Delhi category candidates.
- f) If the complete list of OBC NCL, Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GN, Delhi category candidates.
- g) If the complete list of OBC, Outside Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GN, Outside Delhi category candidates.
- h) If the complete list of ST Delhi candidates exhausts, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of SC, Delhi category candidates

9. Certificates Required for Claiming Reserved Seats

Candidates applying for any reserved seat (i.e., EW, SC, ST, OBC-NCL, CW, PD) must upload the scanned copy of the certificates (as applicable) as mentioned below at the time filling up of the ONLINE application form.

i. Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL):

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), candidate must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs. A list of approved authorities is given below:

- a. District Magistrate/Additional Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/Collector/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- b. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- c. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or her family normally resides.

d. Administrator/Secretary to Administration/Development Officer (Laccadive &Minicoy Islands).

NOTE:

- The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily upload the caste/ category certificate in her name at the time of filling up of the ONLINE form. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (mother/father) or any other family member is not acceptable and the candidate will not be entitled even for provisional admission.
- 2. The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state/region in which the reservation is being claimed, e.g., in case, a candidate claims the seat reserved for the Delhi Region category, she has to bring SC/ ST/OBC certificate issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and should have also passed her qualifying examination from a School / College / Institute located in National Capital Territory of Delhi.
- 3. OBC (NCL) candidates are required to produce a caste certificate issued after March 31, 2022 from the authorities as mentioned above. However, if the certificate is issued prior to March 31, 2022, it must be accompanied with an additional certificate regarding the present non-creamy layer status of the candidate, issued by the same competent authority. This additional certificate must have reference of her already issued original caste certificate.
- 4. Students claiming OBC reservation under Delhi region will be admitted in this category on the submission of a certificate to this effect from the Competent Authority of the Government of NCT of Delhi. Certificate issued by Govt. of India or any state government will not be accepted under any circumstances. A certificate issued by a Competent Authority of Delhi to an individual on the basis of Caste Certificate of her parents from another state will be accepted for claiming a seat under OBC Category IF AND ONLY IF the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- **ii. Defence sub category (CW):** For admission to a seat reserved for Defence sub-category, candidate must produce the following certificates (as applicable), in original, at the time of document verification of Defence candidates:
 - a. Entitlement card in original issued by the Record Officer of the Unit/ Regiment of Armed Personnel of the Armed Forces in case of Armed Personnel.
 - b. Widows/ Wards/ Wives of the officers and men of Armed forces who died or were disabled on duty (both attributable to military service) must produce a certificate to that effect from the following authorities:

- i. Secretary, KendriyaSainik Board.
- ii) Secretary, Rajya / Zila Sainik Board.
- iii) Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
- c. Medical records in original.
- d. Special Pension Order and Passbook indicating special pension.
- e. Gallantry Award Certificate.
- f. Original ex-servicemen Identity Card/Discharge Book/ Pension Payment Order.
- g. Dependency card issued by the competent authority in order to relate the relationship of the candidate with the Defence personnel.
- h. Original Service Identity Card.
- i. A certificate from the respective C.O. Unit in respect of serving personnel.

NOTE: A statement to the effect that 'the death/disability is attributed to military service' is required to be included in the certificate for Priority III & IV.

iii. Person with Disability sub-category:

For admission to seat reserved for person with disabilities (PD) sub-category, the candidate must upload the following certificates at the time of filling up the Online form:

- a. Certificate of physical disability issued by the Competent Authority as per the provisions of the Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 in the prescribed format as given under the Act.
- b. The candidate with benchmark disabilities shall produce the medical certificate issued by the Govt. Hospitals duly notified by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi/ other State government and further duly verified by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned Government Hospital.
- c. A certificate duly recommended by Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for the handicapped, 9-11 Vikas Marg, Karkardooma, Delhi 110092.

11. Admission Procedure

For direct admission for diploma holder candidates in 2nd year B.Tech. (Mechanical & Automation Engineering), all candidates need to register and fill the application ONLINE only by accessing www.igdtuw.ac.in from September 28, 2022 to October 9, 2022 (11 PM). The application process is completed only when a printout of the filled ONLINE application form is taken after paying the online registration fee of INR 1000/-. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in regular diploma in Mechanical Engineering branch. The reporting for admission in the counselling will be offline and the reporting time will be 9 am on the counselling date (13.10.2022) at Mechanical Block, IGDTUW Campus. On date of reporting at IGDTUW during admission, the following documents are to be submitted along with physical verification of original documents:

A duly signed printout of the filled application form (same as submitted ONLINE) along with two good quality photographs (same as uploaded on the online application form) affixed in the appropriate place on the form.

- a. Attested copies of all mark sheets and certificate of qualifying examination $10^{\text{th}}/\text{ITI}$ and Diploma.
- b. Attested copies of SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EW/ PD Certificate(s) whichever applicable, on the basis of which reservation is claimed. OBC-NCL candidates must produce the NCL certificate to support their category as per Annexure-2.
- c. Original copies of all documents for physical verification. If any mismatch is found in physical verification, then admission will be cancelled and necessary disciplinary action as deemed fit will be taken.

Candidates are requested to ensure that they must fulfill all such requirements before filling and applying. **Incomplete application**, due to any reason, is liable for rejection by the University. In this regard, no communication will be entertained.

a) Application Fee

The registration fee of Rs. 1000/- is to be paid online through credit/debit card/net-banking at the time of registration. The registration shall not be complete without the payment of registration fee which is non-refundable and would not be adjusted towards any other fee. A convenience charge (online transaction) will be extra as per banking gateway on every online registration fee payment.

b) Seat Allotment Procedure

The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in regular diploma in Mechanical Engineering/equivalent branch. The candidate having regular Diploma in Mechanical Engineering and equivalent may seek admission in Mechanical and Automation Engineering from the available seats strictly as per the rank in the merit list of relevant categories. In case more than one candidate has the same rank, the marks obtained in the qualifying examination as stated in the eligibility conditions will form the basis of merit for admission. In the event of marks in the qualifying examination also being equal, the candidate older in age will be given preference.

c) Reporting for Admission

A list of provisional selected candidates will be uploaded in IGDTUW website for admission. The candidate needs to report admission committee at IGDTUW for admission on that specified date. Admission will be offered rank wise in respective category. The candidate, who is allotted a seat in a particular round is required to pay the admission fee of Rs. 1,22,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty-two Thousand only) in the form of a DD drawn in favor of the "Registrar, Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women", payable at New Delhi.

- 1. Admission committee will verify all uploaded documents and proof of fee payments for all candidates who are allotted seat. If all documents are verified successfully and fee payment is successful, admission will be confirmed by the admission committee. Once provisional admission letter is issued to the candidate, admission process is complete for such candidates.
- 2. If the candidate is allotted and he/she does not pay the required admission fee as per counseling schedule, her allotted seat shall be cancelled.
- **3.** If admission committee finds some deficiency/deficiencies in uploaded documents and the original documents on the date of admission than the seat allotted is not confirmed by the admission committee.
- **4.** Admission of a candidate is purely provisional and is subject to verification of original documents after the physical reporting of the candidate at the University.

In Person Counselling: All the selected candidates will report on 13th October, 2022 at 9:00 AM in the Mechanical Block, IGDTUW and mark their attendance compulsorily.

13. Fee Structure:

Every applicant who gets the admission offer in the 2nd year B.Tech. (Direct Admission for Diploma Holders) programme shall pay the course fee (AY 2022-23) of 1,22,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty-Two Thousand Only) in favour of "Registrar, IGDTUW" payable at Kashmere Gate, Delhi- 110006. The break-up of this admission fee is as under:

a. Annual Fee: Rs. 1,15,000/-

b. Security Deposit (refundable): Rs. 5000/-

c. One time Alumni Fee: Rs. 2000/-

14. Documents Required at the Time of Counselling

Candidates are required to produce all the original certificates and two sets of self attested photocopies in support of their candidature at the time of document verification.

Following is the list of essential documents required for the counselling:

- a. Print-out of the online application form duly signed by the candidate with four passport size photo.
- b. Date of Birth proof
- c. 10th/ITI mark sheet and certificate
- d. Diploma mark sheet and certificate
- e. Caste Certificate for SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PD/CW/EW if applicable. Candidates belonging to OBC-NCL & EW will be required to submit the certificates issued on or later than 1st April 2022.
- f. ID Proof Aadhar card/Driving License/Voter ID/PAN Card
- g. Proof of CGPA/CPI conversion to percentage.
- h. Proof of payment of Rs. 1000/- as registration fee.
- i. Medical Fitness Certificate
- j. Undertaking for Final Year Appearing Candidates. Candidates who are appearing in their final semester/final year examination (i.e. their qualifying degree result is awaited), have to fill the undertaking form. Any Seat offered to a final year appearing candidate will be purely provisional and subject to fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria. If such candidate is unable to meet minimum eligibility criteria till the date declared by the University, her admission shall be cancelled and no fee will be refunded.

Candidate will be eligible for final seat allotment subject to the following conditions:

- Verification of all documents at the time of counselling and fulfilling of the eligibility criteria
- Availability of seat in the required field and payment of fees for the program.

If the candidate fails to produce any required documents, her candidature is liable to be cancelled. In case, the candidate fails to fulfil minimum eligibility criteria, her admission shall be cancelled and no fee will be refunded. Admission may be cancelled even after seat allotment & submission of fee if any data/document provided by the applicant is found to be incorrect.


