Tenure of Fellowship	Engagement for the position of JRF will be made for ONE year initially, which may be extended for another year subject to the satisfactory performance of the candidate and also availability of the budget. Tenure may be extended year by year basis up to tenure of the project January 2029 and availability of the budget.
