All the eligible candidates are requested to download RAT-2024 (Winter Session) Admit Card from their respective login accounts on Admission Portal (https://igdtuw.in/IGDTUW_ADMISSION/login) on 8th January, 2025. If any discrepancies found, please report to examination division, IGDTUW on or before 09th January latest by 3:00 P.M.
2. RAT examination would comprise of 60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) divided into two parts: PART A: This part shall carry 30 MCQ questions pertaining to research aptitude, logical reasoning, analytical and numerical ability, graphical analysis, quantitative comparison, data interpretation and reading comprehension.
PART B: This part shall carry 30 MCQ questions pertaining to the subject. The RAT exam would be of 60 marks where each question would carry 01 mark. The RAT shall be qualifying exam with qualifying marks as 50%. The duration of the RAT exam would be 02 hrs.

4. Bring Identity Card issued by Employer/Adhaar Card/Election Card/Driving License/Passport in Original for proof of identity.
5. Bring two copies of admit cards with duly pasted recent passport size photographs in both admit cards with self-attested.
6. No candidate will be allowed to appear for the examination without admit card. The Admit Card must be produced for verification in the examination hall.
7. Hand Bags, Purse, Electronic gadgets like Mobile, Calculator etc. are not allowed inside the Examination Hall.
8. Report to University Campus (Examination Centre) at least 30 minutes before commencement of Written Examination.
9. No candidate will be allowed to enter examination hall once the examination has started.
10. Candidate can leave the examination hall only after scheduled time of exam is over.
11. Upon completion of the examination, please wait for instructions from the Invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised. The candidates will be permitted to move out, one at a time only.
12. All candidates are required to download and read carefully the Instructions given with the Admit Card and strictly adhere to them.
13. The Admit Card is provisional, subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as given in the Information Bulletin.
14. Candidate should retain one copy of the Admit card (with invigilator's signature) till the admission process is finished. Second copy should be handed over to the Invigilator at the time of written Test. Duplicate admit cards will not be issued after the test.
15. Issue of admit card does not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which will be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.
16. Candidates must sit according to the seat allocated to them.
17. Use only Black/Blue ball point pen for filling of the OMR Answer Sheet.
18. Keep visiting www.igdtuw.ac.in and keep checking your emails (from: phdadmissions@igdtuw.ac.in) regularly for further information.
19. The applicants are advised to check the location of University well in advance so that they can reach their examination centre/Hall without any problem/delay on the date of Entrance examination.
20. It is also informed that in any circumstances **“NO CANDIDATES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EXAMINATION CENTRE AFTER THE SCHEDULED COMMENCEMENT OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION”**.
21. No Candidate should adopt any unfair means or indulge in any unfair examination practices. If any candidate is found indulging in any unfair means/unfair examination practices at any stage of examination, her candidature will be cancelled, and legal action will be taken including debarring in all future examinations.
22. If religion/customs require you to wear specific attire, please visit the Centre early for thorough checking and mandatory frisking.
23. No Candidate would be allowed to enter the Examination Centre, without Admit Card and Valid ID Proof, and proper frisking.

24. Candidates will be permitted to carry only the following items with them in the examination venue:
- a. Personal transparent water bottle
 - b. Transparent Ball Point Pen
 - c. Two copy of Admit Card downloaded from admission portal.
 - d. Original valid ID proof
25. The RAT-exempted candidates are required to appear directly for the interview as per the schedule displayed by IGDTUW at a later date.
