# Report: OPTICA STUDENTS CHAPTER IGDTUW 3D CAD TOURNAMENT

#### Introduction:

The Optica Students Chapter IGDTUW organized a successful CAD Tournament aimed at promoting learning and skill enhancement within the field. The event comprised three rounds designed to test the participants' knowledge, speed, and accuracy in Computer-Aided Design (CAD). The tournament was conducted seamlessly with the aid of Unstop App for registrations and logistical organization.

#### Brief of the Session:

#### 1. Registration and Quiz Round:

The tournament commenced with an online registration process through the Unstop App. Initially, there were 38 enthusiastic participants who registered for the event. Among them, 24 individuals attempted the quiz round on the Unstop platform, showcasing their proficiency and qualifying for the subsequent round.

#### 2. Online Elimination Round:

The second round, held offline, faced limitations for out-of-Delhi registrants due to logistical constraints. Out of the initial 24 qualifiers, 11 participants were eligible for further rounds, and 6 participants actively engaged in the final round. The tournament progression included 6 participants in Round 1, 4 participants in Round 2, and finally, 3 participants in the ultimate Round 3.

#### 3. Final Round and Winner:

The concluding stage of the tournament witnessed intense competition among the top 3 participants, culminating in Alisha Dhingia, a dedicated 2nd-year DMAM student, securing the prestigious title of tournament winner, showcasing remarkable skills and expertise in CAD.
